### The Bible's Pre-Christian God



The Bible recounts about 6000 years from the creation of Adam until our day. We can see, by looking at any calendar, Jesus was born about 2000 years ago. Who was the God that dealt with mankind during the 4000 years before Christ? Who made the wonderful promises to Abraham and to his seed? Who spoke to Moses and split the Red Sea? Is it important that we know him? What did Jesus teach about him?

#### Understanding the Bible

Bible teachers who pick a scripture here, and pick a scripture there, can make the Bible seem impossible to understand. It becomes simple, however, if you try to view it in context.

Seeing the Bible in context only means becoming familiar with it by gaining an overview of its purpose. For example: If you were sitting looking for your first time at an unaltered rubix cube (a 3 inch plastic square with each of its six sides a different color) sitting on a shelf, it would be hard to know what it is was from your one perspective. Your view might be that of a simple blue square. Another person, seated 90 degrees around the object from you, might be seeing a yellow square. Still a third person standing so his view is above and between the two of you might see a sort of three colored pyramid. All would be correct in describing what they were seeing, but none would really understand what they were looking at. And, their descriptions would be very confusing to a fourth party. That person might think the other three were a little crazy. If each person were able to pick up the cube and roll it around in their hands, each would fully understand what they are looking at and the reason for their varied descriptions; including the confused bystander. Such a thorough examination and an open discussion about it would also reveal the cubes purpose. To really grasp the point we are making, you must begin to consider the great difference between religion and Christianity. Christians are continually rolling the Bible around in their mind (by reading it) while religionists (speaking here of those religions who do lay claim to being Christian) have picked a few scriptures and are looking at the Bible from the one viewpoint their few scriptures afford them. They are continually trying to reinforce and defend that one same view, from the point of view they have selected for themselves, but they won't pick up the Bible and really examine it.

Rolling the Bible around in their hands, by always remaining sincere students of its pages, is what religious sects actually try to keep their members from doing. That defines religion as different from Christianity. They just can't help themselves. While most religious

groups no doubt started out being Bible students, they have each decided and determined to set themselves apart as being the only group who has the one and only true understanding of the Bible. They each become consumed with teaching their particular viewpoint to others, rather than continuing on to examine the Bible so as to gain an ever clearer understanding (by actually reading it). They each demand that members adhere to their organizational dogma or doctrine. They all fail to realize Jesus Christ is the one and only person to understand and explain the Bible. Read what Jesus said! What we are describing really isn't confusing or hard to recognize. If you are a member of a religious group, do they meet to actually read the Bible? Or, do they keep you buried in Bible study aids published by their sect? Do they expect you to listen for an hour to a lecture with half a dozen scriptures sprinkled through? That is not Bible study. Understanding the difference between Christianity and religion, i just like understanding all the rest of

the Bible, becomes an easy thing<sup>2</sup> for those who sincerely examine what it says. Jesus said religions go wrong simply because they don't know what the Bible says.<sup>3</sup> We encourage you to join us in examining the Bible from what might seem a little different perspective than you have viewed before. Although your religious leaders might try to convince you otherwise, there is never any reason to fear undertaking such a study. It is the Bible's prescribed method for making yourself noble minded. All you have to do to make yourself noble minded is to make sure everything you are told finds support in the Bible!<sup>4</sup> If you know a scripture that says the Bible is a blue square (from our example above), don't doubt that scripture you already know because someone can show you another scripture that says it is a red square. Just continue to meditate on both those scriptures, along with all the others you can find

kingdom of heaven. Only the ones who obey my Father in heaven will get in. (22) On the day of judgment many will call me their Lord. that bear on the subject, until the one and only clear scriptural picture of truth emerges. As you gain Bible knowledge, read over and over what Jesus taught you in the Gospels. That is God's prescribed process for becoming a noble minded person. (4) Toward the goal of becoming ever more familiar with the Bible, then, please consider what the scriptures say about the pre-Christian God of the Old Testament record.

An examination shows studious men have accurately traced the Bible record to account for about 6000 years of time from the creation of Adam until our day (about 6040 years actually, as of 2015). The Bible is divided into two sections, the Old Testament (or Hebrew Scriptures) and the New Testament (or Christian Greek Scriptures). The Old Testament (OT) portion of the Bible accounts for about 2/3 of its volume, and contains the record of the first 4000 years of mankind's Bible recorded history. Christianity was introduced as recorded by the New Testament (NT) about 2000 years ago (and about 4000 years after the creation of Adam, putting us 6000 years from that creation until today. Christianity was brought to birth in 29 CE when Jesus presented himself as the promised Jewish Messiah: Matthew 3:13-17 MWT Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to John, in order to be baptized by him. <sup>14</sup> But John kept objecting and said: "I am the one needing to be baptized by you, and are you coming to me?" 15 In reply Jesus said to him: "For now this is how it should be, because we must do all that God wants us to do." Then he quit preventing him. 16 After being baptized Jesus immediately came up from the water; and, look! the heavens were opened up, and he saw descending like a dove God's spirit coming upon him. 17 Look! Also, there was a

voice from the heavens that said: "This is my own dear Son, the beloved, and I am pleased with him." Who, then, was the God who spoke to Jesus when he came up from the water? Who was the Bible's God during that 4000 year record before Christ? Who promised to produce a Messiah to help mankind? Do you think it's important to know who He is? Since God persistently had His name recorded for us in those Old Testament (OT) Scriptures, might it be important to know that name? What was He teaching mankind during all those years before Christ? Since He dedicated 2/3 of the Bible to that Old Testament record, and therein recorded his divine name over 6000 times, doesn't it make the name of God and his teachings seem important? Of course it does! What, then, does this pre-Christian God teach us in the Old Testament? How does it bear upon the teachings by Christ as recorded for us in the first four Gospel books of the New Testament?

The Old and New Testaments are, of course, one Bible! One of the most wonderful things about the Bible is its consistency and integrity. The Bible is all truth, and the more you learn about any one part of it, the more you know about the rest of it because of how it's intertwined. That includes learning about both the Old and New Testaments. For those who have chosen to express faith in Christ Jesus, while having little knowledge of the OT, do not be alarmed by our line of thinking. It is only good in every way to learn about the God who predates Christianity. Such knowledge will surely strengthen your faith in Christ.

We might start with knowing and appreciating the name of the God of the OT. He introduced himself to us as Jehovah,<sup>7</sup> saying that He is our

God's personal name in the original Hebrew Characters is הוהי. Those four Hebrew letters correspond to YHVH or YHWH and translate to Jehovah in English. Some prefer Yahweh as the English translation but it seems neither is more accurate than the other. Jehovah is most well-known and accepted. Some translators removed the divine name from their translation works. Many substituted LORD in all capitols when they replaced Jehovah, and used Lord when the original Hebrew word actually meant lord. When you see LORD in most translations, it should read Jehovah.

salvation,<sup>8</sup> that we should trust in Him forever,<sup>9</sup> and that He, whose name alone is Jehovah, is the most high God of all.<sup>10</sup> Having had his personal name used over 6000 times in the most ancient copies of the original Hebrew Scriptures, it would seem he wanted us to know the divine name!

As for those who already believe in Christ Jesus, then, how do they reconcile a belief in both Jehovah God and Christ Jesus. Again, the nice thing about the Bible is we never need to reconcile anything... Both Jehovah and Christ made their relationship clear in their respective teachings. All we need do is open our mind to the Bible, and then listen and learn. (We must be very cautious to avoid being derailed by wellmeaning religious people who are stuck on the red square (from the illustration above), and who want to stick us there as well. They are convinced they are right, after all, and everyone else is wrong.) In Luke 10:21, 11 Jesus thanked his Father that He had hidden the truth from wise and intellectual people (those who have no real interest in truth) and made it clear to ordinary people. Jesus went on to say: (Luke 10:22 & 23 CEV) My Father has given me everything, and he is the only one who knows the Son. The only one who really knows the Father is the Son. But the Son wants to tell others about the Father, so that they can know him too. (23) Jesus then turned to his disciples and said to them in private, "You are really blessed to see what you see!" We can be "blessed" today, just as were Jesus disciples. All we need do is listen to

what he taught us about his Father Jehovah, and what the Father taught us in the OT as well. The Old and New Testaments are inextricably linked in purpose.

Very early in the 4000 year record of the Hebrew Scriptures, immediately after Adam and Eve sinned, Jehovah God (the Father Jesus spoke to and about, and the God<sup>12</sup> he prayed to<sup>13</sup> so often) made all of mankind a promise. As the first promise recorded in the Bible, Jehovah prophesied He would raise up a seed from the woman who would crush Satan's head.<sup>14</sup> (Satan is the spirit creature who instigated the rebellion by Adam and Eve.) Jehovah could have instantly crushed all three of them, of course. Satan had asserted, however, that God was bad in his course to withhold something from Adam and Eve, and that they would be better off disobeying God.<sup>15</sup> Satan also implied God's creation was

bad, and would all turn against him if put to the test. <sup>16</sup> Killing the three of them instantly would not have settled the issues raised by Satan in front of all God's other children in heaven (and even on earth in the yet unborn sons and daughters of Adam and Eve). Settling those issues would be the purpose and task of the "seed of the woman" whom Jehovah promised to raise up. <sup>17</sup> That promised deliverer would clear Jehovah's name of the reproach Satan placed upon it. That would include, not only proving Jehovah was perfect in his rulership, but proving his creation was good as well. <sup>18</sup> Rather than defend himself, Jehovah would allow his son to do so. <sup>(36)</sup> They were about to prove that because some of God's creatures had chosen to use their wondrous gift of freedom to make themselves bad, it does not mean the creation is defective. The defect was their own. <sup>19</sup>

Following their sin (rebellion), Jehovah spent the next 4000 years of the OT record producing that promised seed of the woman. (It is doubful God needed so much time. The time allowed the children of Adam and Eve (us) to continue to be born. We have the hope and chance for eternal life because of 6000 years allowed to pass since the Garden rebellion.) God's choice of that promised seed was a very important matter. Jehovah had stated the seed would prove faithful, at the same time knowing the choice to be faithful would rest within the coming Messiah himself. (The "seed of the woman" later came to be referred to as the "Messiah.") The OT told us many things about the coming Messiah (or Christ – both titles meaning "anointed one"), so mankind would be able to identify him when he arrived. Jehovah even gave prophecies indicating when the Christ would arrive. People who studied the Hebrew Scriptures were thus looking for the Christ when Jesus presented himself in 29 CE<sup>20</sup> to be the "seed of the woman" promised back in Gen 3:15. (14) All any person has to do to take Jehovah's side in the issue of who has the right to decide what is good and bad, is to express faith in Christ Jesus as the son of God; and, as Jesus called himself, as the son of man (or seed of the woman).<sup>21</sup> Jesus explained to

some religious people how the earth was likened to a vineyard left by his Father, so it could produce people who would be obedient as God's sons and daughters. God sent the people prophets and leaders all during the four thousand years before Christ, and the people rejected and killed most of them. Finally, Jehovah would send his only son, but they would kill him too. When the religious leaders heard these words from Jesus they started trying to kill him, for they realized he was talking about them.<sup>22</sup> Religion has not changed since they killed Jesus. Religion still hates the truth down to this day, because it exposes them

for the hypocrites they are.<sup>23</sup> The religious leaders of Jesus day had all kinds of traditions they looked to and used to justify themselves.<sup>24</sup> They

followed their traditions instead of Jesus. Modern religion does exactly the same.<sup>25</sup> They are all looking at the blue square, or red square, or whatever few scriptures they have selected to build their faith on.

Look past the sectarian beliefs of men. Can you see how the Bible reveals our gaining hope and life has been a simple and consistent process for all those 6000 years of Bible record? Jehovah's eyes have always been roving about in the earth to find every single person of goodwill; every person who desires to be a part of Jehovah's good creation (when given that opportunity). Every righteously inclined person Jehovah has found, has been helped by him. For the first 4000 years, He led them to hope in and look forward to, the coming Messiah. Those who died before Jesus's arrival died in the hope of a resurrection. Starting 2000 years ago, instead of hoping in a coming Messiah, Jehovah has been leading upright individuals to the teachings of his son. There was no more looking forward to the coming Messiah. God had the teachings of the Christ recorded by Matthew, Mark, Luke

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worship me, when you teach rules made up by humans." (8) You disobey God's commands in order to obey what humans have taught. (9) You are good at rejecting God's commands so that you can follow your own teachings! (10) Didn't Moses command you to respect your father and mother? Didn't he tell you to put to death all who curse their parents? (11) But you let people get by without helping their parents when they should. You let them say that what they own has been offered to God. (12) You won't let those people help their parents. (13) And you ignore God's commands in order to follow your own teaching. You do a lot of other things that are just as bad.

and the apostle John.<sup>29</sup> God now leads all sincere people to the teachings of Jesus. When any one of us turns to Jesus in faith, Jesus teaches us about his Father Jehovah from the Gospels.<sup>30</sup> Jesus said our very life depends on knowing both he and his Father.<sup>31</sup> When Jesus finally and fully submits to his Father Jehovah, his doing so will make him the exact opposite of Satan and Adam and Eve. By his unwavering and everlasting obedience, Jesus provides the eternal solution to all of creation's problems.<sup>32</sup> All faithful creation will worship Jehovah forever, in paradise and peace, with the faithfulness of the Christ resting as a shield over us forever.<sup>33</sup> Every action ever taken by Jehovah has been

seems their "great signs" mostly amount to the great cloud of people they have been able to mislead so they will follow after *them*. Many of these sects have large followings and are well accredited by mankind. Do not be deceived. Reading your Bible is your simple protection. You can know false prophets by whether they are actually learning and teaching what Jesus Christ taught.<sup>38</sup> In the interest of helping people recognize the Bible to be simple and easy to understand, we try to gain and share different viewpoints so as to avoid becoming sectarian and judgmental. That said, however, you should always demand scriptural support for what is taught, by anyone and everyone you listen to. That is the oh-so-simple way you can know you are not being deceived by us, or by any other person or sect. Use the Bible to verify everything you are told. God himself refers to individuals who do so as noble minded.<sup>(4)</sup>

Religion only amounts to a badge you wear in the form of your membership in any one of the many religious sects. You give your worship to the group in the form of your time, energy and resources; and they are anxious to provide you with their promise and assurance you are on the road to salvation or paradise. Their blessing is based on your approved membership, and in your performing the works they give you to do. (Those works can range from sitting in attendance at group meetings, to volunteering to help with building projects or to do evangelizing work. Some of them actually do harm to other people while they imagine they are serving God.) Christianity is very different from that. It is based on your personal faith in your personal knowledge of the teachings of Christ Jesus. It is what you are inside, and is always reflected in your love for Jehovah and other humans. You are able to
